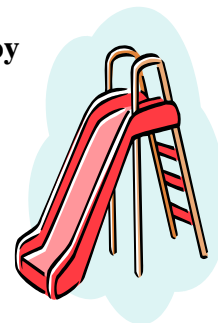

Following his presentation, a winning opportunity was selected for Larry, but the Joker was elsewhere! --- *Hail, Kiwanis!*

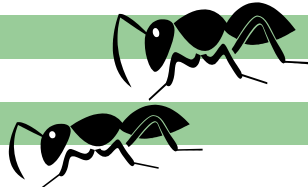
