The on-site non-public school serves both the Center and 14 public schools that send students with special concerns. Charmaine thanked us for our participation in refurbishing the playground area that has shown to be so important in working with their autistic children.

David King of Isaiah's Rock states that "the Poor" just gets bigger. Recipients of their food distribution programs are not "Street People" but Working Class Poor and the Elderly. As difficult as their own circumstances are, all of their recipient families are encouraged to share with others – "You all have something to give." The Toy Line, Food Line, and Santa Line all come together on December 19 at Chino City Hall beginning at 8:00 a.m. – please join in the distributions.


## WALNUT VALLEY KIWANIS CLUB
