Richard will provide the meats for the grill and we will have club members sign up for a potluck on the side dishes. (Aggie already has dibs on bringing the potato salad!)

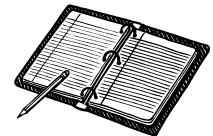
Larry McMillan was contacted by a financial planner who would like to our club. Larry will arrange his visit during the month of August – Larry’s presidential reign, by the way!

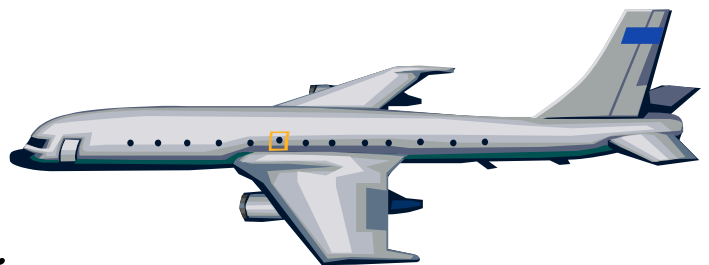
