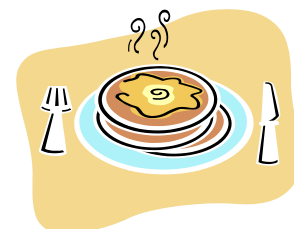
KIWANIS CLUB OF WALNUT VALLEY

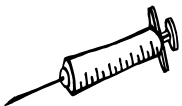
