Happy, Happy, Happy dollars paid by...

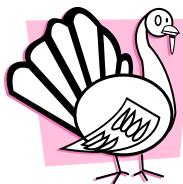
...Don Nettles - \$1.00 for just being happy...

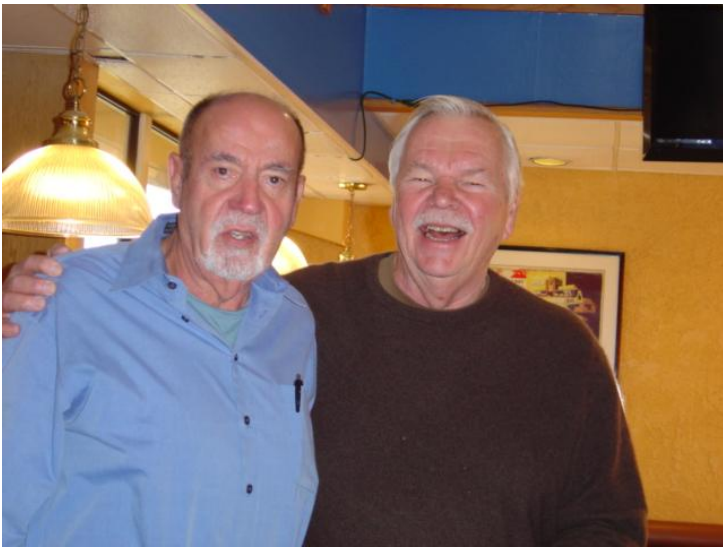

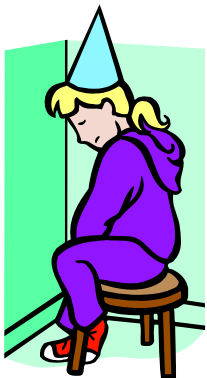
