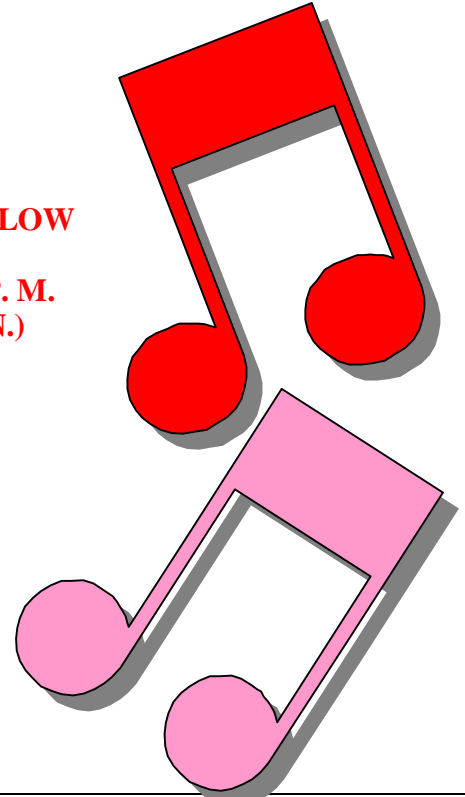
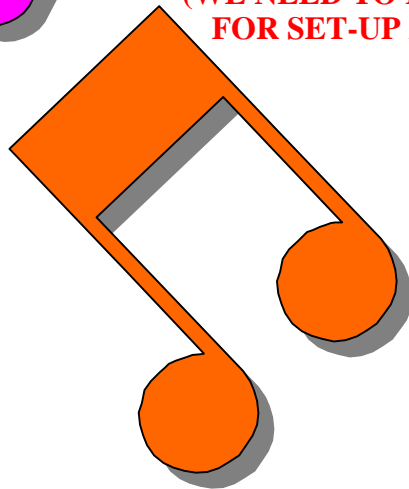
Following his presentation, a winning opportunity was selected for Bert Brandt, but the Joker remained in hiding. *** Hail, Kiwanis!
