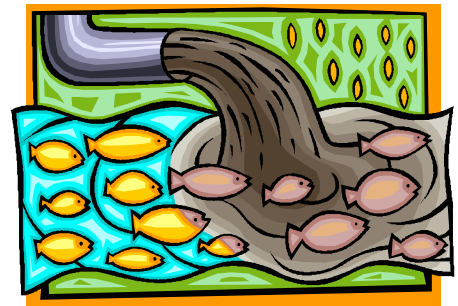




WALNUT VALLEY KIWANIS CLUB
